## **Kimberley Saddle Competition – Novice Campdraft**

Derby Outback Rodeo & Camp draft are running a Novice campdraft competition this year with the prize being a half breed saddle donated partly by Lone Oak Saddlery.

There will also be \$200 to the winner who have competed in each of the novice drafts in Fitzroy Crossing, Halls Creek & Derby that has nominated in the Challenge, this is sponsored by Andy & Lisa Wearing Equine Dentist.

The competition will be held in conjunction with Fitzroy, Halls Creek and Derby rodeos and points for each rider will be accumulated at these 3 campdrafts. Points will be accumulated in the novice events only and will be horse and rider combination.

Nominations will be accepted at FVRC campdraft as this is the first draft.

There will be one off fee paid at **FVRC of \$45** to enter the competition.

**This event is not open to any competitors who have won an OPEN CAMPDRAFT.**

The top 10 riders will then be invited to run in a 2 round final to be held on Saturday 10th of August 2019 at Derby Campdraft. This will be a winner take all based on aggregate score in this final. It will be an unaffiliated event and will not be status breaking or receive points.

### **Points will be as follow:**

- 1<sup>st</sup> = 11 points
- 2<sup>nd</sup> = 10 points
- 3<sup>rd</sup> = 9 points
- 4<sup>th</sup> = 8 points
- 5<sup>th</sup> = 7 points
- 6<sup>th</sup> = 6 points
- 7<sup>th</sup> = 5 points
- 8<sup>th</sup> = 4 points
- 9<sup>th</sup> = 3 points
- 10 = 2 points

### **Rules will be as follows.**

1. Horse and rider combination. There will be no substitution of horse or rider for any reason.
2. If a horse breaks status then that horse will only be able to compete in the final if it has accumulated enough points prior to the status being broken. This applies to horses going from novice to open status.
3. The final will be a 2 round final with winner being decided on aggregate score in that final only. If there is a tie for first, then those rides will ride off again until there is a clear winner
4. If there is a tie at a draft say 4<sup>th</sup> place ties with two riders then the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> points will be split between those riders and then the next place getters will be 6<sup>th</sup> and so on.
5. Points will be kept by Derby committee.
6. Any disputes with points will be ratified by a disputes committee. These names will be announced closer to the event.

**Any rider that has won an Open Campdraft is ineligible to nominate**
